This program is *anxiety-free* compared to programs that expect the parishioner to articulate the message on their own. Distribution of this comprehensive booklet *can be as easy* as a smile and the words, "I have a gift for you." These booklets have accompanied "get well" cards, email attachments, and have been linked to social media.

The first booklet is "Real Prayer" which concludes by asking the reader to consider a local "faith-based" church. *This provides an opportunity for follow-up.*

- ✦ **The first four pages** of this booklet deal with God, the bible, grace, and prayer in a way that people can relate to. Personal issues such as submission, forgiveness, and temptation are presented in a non-offensive way as this booklet offers workable solutions.



The second booklet, "Grace," strengthens the parishioner:

- ✦ There is a *dramatic* difference in the results, "*whether we choose*" how to serve Jesus or whether we gain the Christian maturity to "*abide in Jesus Christ*," John 15:1-11. This booklet helps us recognize the guidance of the Holy Spirit along with the personal growth needed to be a more effective disciple of Jesus Christ.



Locate the moment when a person's heart is open to listening:

- † Our greatest opportunity for success is "to abide in Christ" through prayer and listening to the Holy Spirit. Sometimes our role may only be a step or two in a multi-step process.
- † People tend to be more open to considering options when they are uncomfortable with life. Whether it may be a health issue (when the person is not blaming God**) or another struggle; such moments need evaluated.
